Introduction

November 17 and 18 the Dutch Kyokushin Organization (NKKO), in collaboration with the Kyokushin World Federation organizes the WC Kyokushin in the city of Arnhem, Holland. Participation in the championship is only possible for country teams affiliated and/or cooperating with the KWU and or the Shinkyokushin.

This event will be held at SportsCenter Valkenhuizen in Arnhem.



Arnhem is a city in the east of Holland and located on the banks of the Rhine River and surrounded by beautiful forests and parks, such as the Sonsbeek Park and the Veluwe National Park.

Arnhem is also known because of The Battle of Arnhem. This was a major World War II battle fought in and around the city in September 1944. It was a key battle in Operation Market Garden, which was intended to end the war before Christmas 1944. The battle had a significant impact on the city and is remembered through various monuments, museums, and events.

Arnhem has a rich cultural and historical heritage. The city has many museums, such as the Netherlands Open Air Museum, the Airborne Museum, and the Museum Arnhem, which showcase the city's history and art.



From Schiphol Airport (Amsterdam) you can travel to Arnhem directly by train. This is a one-hour travel by train and a direct connection.

The Championship rules.

This is a Kyokushin World Championship organized by the KWF therefore the KWF rules will be applied. The championship is in kumite and in kata as well for children, juniors and seniors including the old boy's category.

GENERAL RULES:

The number of participants is limited. So, send only your best karateka's. This is not for beginners! If the number of participants is more than we can handle, we must put a limit to participation.

Be very careful and select the correct weight-categories, the organization can disqualify participants if their weight is not the same as mentioned in the registration form.

The KWF can modify categories if there are not enough participants.

Registration only through kumite technology

Registration will be done by kumite technology. Use your email address to make an account and register your fighters.

Check in

The weight in and the check in will be done Thursday 16th of November 2023 at Hotel Bilderberg. All the competitors, referees and officials must come together at the same time as a group and country.

The competitor who will participate in kumite and kata - must pay € 90.

On the weight-check- in you must be prepared to give the following documents:

- Parents agreement to participate (only for competitors under 18 years old).
- Fighter waiver
- IDC or Passport (to check the nationality and age).
- KWF passport or passport of the organization you belong to
- Doctors certificate (only for kumite competitors).
- Must pay the participation fee.
- Each competitor must have a personal insurance for any accident that may occur at the competitor.

Draw

Judging Team under supervision of Main Judge Antonio Pinero, General Secretary Andre Drewniak, Technical Judge Fernando Perez and the Computer specialist will conduct an open draw on November 16th after 22:00

REFEREE-course

Shihan Perez will provide the Referee Course that will take place in Hotel Bilderberg at Thursday evening at 19.00 and will take three hours (1,5 hour for kata and kumite each).

Participation is obligatory for all referees and judges and is free, except for those who want to obtain the title of International Judge or Referee given by the Kyokushin World Federation (KWF). The fee and requirements are:

- International Judge: 50 € (must be minimum 2nd dan and National referee).
- ➤ International Referee: 75 € (must be minimum 3rd dan and International Judge).

The official dress will be:

- Dark Blue trousers,
- Dark blue shirt with short sleeves,
- White bow tie,
- Whistle.

SAYONARA-party

Saturday night at 20.00 there will be a sayonara party at the Bilderberg hotel. Costs are € 35 per person. You must apply for this on Thursday during registration. The fee for the sayonara party must be paid to bank account of the Organizer before October 15, 2023
