

Introduction

November 17 and 18, 2023 the Dutch Kyokushin Organization (NKKO), in collaboration with the Kyokushin World Federation organizes the WC Kyokushin in the city of Arnhem, Holland. Participation in the championship is only possible for country teams affiliated and/or cooperating with the KWU and or the Shinkyokushin organization.

Travelling from Schiphol to Arnhem

If you arrive at Schiphol, the best way to travel to Arnhem is by train. The railway station is below the main hall at Schiphol. You must buy a ticket to Arnhem Central before you enter the station. It is not possible to buy a ticket in the station or in the train. You can pay by card.

Best is to take the train at the hour or half past the hour so you must not change trains in Utrecht. When you arrive in Arnhem take a taxi to your hotel. Except when you stay in IBIS. This hotel is located right across the main entrance of Arnhem Central railway station.

Travelling from Eindhoven to Arnhem

Take the bus to Eindhoven railway station and buy a ticket to Arnhem Central. When you arrive in Arnhem take a taxi to your hotel. Except when you stay in IBIS. This hotel is located right across the main entrance of Arnhem Central station.

Travelling between hotel and the venue: sports center Valkenhuizen

There is shuttle transport between Hotel the Bilderberg, Hotel Fletcher Doorwerth and Sports Center Valkenhuizen.

Costs: you must buy a ticket a €15 per person for two days of the Championship

Morning: two shuttles between 07.30 and 08.30

Afternoon: two shuttles between 18.00 and 19.00

Travelling between Ibis hotel and the venue: sports center Valkenhuizen

In front of the hotel there is a bus station. You must take line 7 direct to Valkenhuizen. The trip lasts for approx. 20 minutes.

Friday morning: every 10 minutes. Line 7 Friday afternoon every 15 minutes Line 7

Saturday morning: 07.03 – 07.23 Line 7

Saturday evening: 18.10 - 18.25 - 18.39 etc Line 7



The Championship rules.

This is a Kyokushin World Championship organized by the KWF therefore the KWF rules will be applied. Kata's must be executed conform the KWF rules. The championship is in kumite and in kata as well for children, juniors and seniors including the old boy's category. The KWF can modify categories if there are not enough participants.

Registration and Check in

The weight in and the check in will be done:

Thursday 16th of November 2023 between 12.00 and 20.00 at Hotel Bilderberg.

All the competitors, referees and officials must come together at the same time as a group and country. There is no individual check in possible. So be in time!

Participation fee per fighter is €45. This must be payed by bank transfer to KWF:

The competitor who will participate in kumite and kata - must pay € 90.

Procedure of Check in:

Before checking in the team must be complete, all participants, referees, officials, and coaches must be present led by their country representative.

Station 1 (KWF)

- Treasurer of the KWF will check if the team is complete and if the necessary fees have been paid.
- Treasurer will also check if the national yearly fee has been paid. If not you must pay in cash
- o If not, you must pay in cash € 45 per participant per category.
- KWF members must show their official KWF-passport. If you do not have one, you must buy a new one.

Station 2 (Organizer)

- Check of the KWF passport.
- The weight will be checked and the registration in Kumite technology is complete.
- The participant will receive his/hers zekken (number)

- On the weight-check- in you must be prepared to give the following documents:
 - Parents agreement to participate (only for competitors under 18 years old).
 - Fighter waiver
 - ID card or Passport (to check the nationality and age).
 - KWF passport or passport of the organization you belong to
 - Doctors certificate (only for kumite competitors).
 - Own protectors (only for kumite competitors).
 - Must pay the participation fee.
 - Each competitor must have a personal insurance for any accident that may occur at the competition.

Station 3 (Organizer)

- o Alle participants receive a bag.
- o All referees and officials will receive their badge.
- Coaches: there is a maximum of 6 coach IDs for a group of up to 10 players and 12 coach IDs for a group of significantly more than 10 players. I you want to bring more coaches, you can buy additional coach badges of €40.
- O Bus tickets: if you stay at the Bilderberg, you can buy a bus ticket for transportation between the hotel and the sport Centre. The price for a ticket is €15 and is valid for Friday and Saturday.
- Sayanara party: you will receive your sayonara tickets here if you have preordered them. If you need extra sayonara tickets, we prefer you order them online asap. There are a limited number of tickets available to buy during the check-in. The price is €35 per person.
- o In this station you can pay by cash and by card.

Draw

Judging Team under supervision of Main Judge Antonio Pinero, General Secretary Andre Drewniak, Technical Judge Fernando Perez will conduct an open draw on November 16th after 22:00. Location: The Bilderberg Hotel

REFEREE-course

Shihan Perez will provide the Referee Course that will take place in Hotel Bilderberg at Thursday evening at 19.00 and will take three hours (1,5 hour for kata and kumite each).

Participation is obligatory for all referees and judges and is free, except for those who want to obtain the title of International Judge or Referee given by the Kyokushin World Federation (KWF). The fee and requirements are:

- International Judge: 50 € (must be minimum 2nd dan and National referee).
- International Referee: 75 € (must be minimum 3rd dan and International Judge).

The official dress is:

- Dark Blue trousers,
- Dark blue shirt with short sleeves,

- White bow tie,
- Whistle.

Official opening

The official opening will take place on Saturday at 14:00. All competitors are required to attend in their dogi.

SAYONARA-party

Saturday night at 20.00 there will be a sayonara party at the Bilderberg hotel. Costs are € 35 per person. You must apply for this on Thursday during registration. The fee for the sayonara party must be paid to bank account of the Organizer before October 15, 2023
